On Thursday, May 4, 2006 United States District Court Judge Marcia Cook, Granted preliminary approval of class action settlement in Case no.: 05-22968-CIV-COOKE styled *Borcea et al. v. Carnival Corporation* and the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals issued a stay and remand to lower court for settlement approval of Case no.: 05-20644-CIV-COOKE styled *Stoycheva et. al. v. Carnival Corporation*. Under the terms of the proposed settlement, Carnival has agreed to settle both cases for six million two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$6,250,000.00). This money has been deposited and will be used to pay out claims submitted by each class member who post marks a completed claim form by September 15, 2006 and the same is received by the claims administrator by September 25, 2006.

Each class member will receive notification directly from Carnival Cruise Lines along with a claims form and instruction on how to fill out. Each class member will also receive an opt out form which needs to be received by the claims administrator by the same dateline.
